



How to make a cornfield meadow pot



- Make drainage holes if necessary, drill 5-10 mm diameter holes into the bottom of the pot about 15 cm apart.
- 2. Cover with crocks.
- 3. Half fill with peat-free compost.
- 4. Start planting! Continue building up plants and compost until about 5 cm from the top.
- 5. Feed once a week and water frequently in summer.
- 6. Sow each year.
