



How to make a cornfield meadow pot



1. Make drainage holes – if necessary, drill 5-10 mm diameter holes into the bottom of the pot about 15 cm apart.
2. Cover with crocks.
3. Half fill with peat-free compost.
4. Start planting! Continue building up plants and compost until about 5 cm from the top.
5. Feed once a week and water frequently in summer.
6. Sow each year.

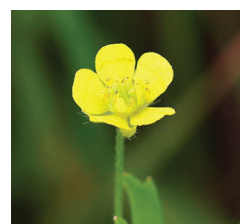
