



Cleaning Shoes/Boots (P12)



After lots of gardening and jet washing, my boots need a good clean and polish!
I am cleaning my boots outside, away from food.
Make sure to put down some newspaper to protect surfaces.



I need to clean off the mud first. Fill a bowl with warm soapy water, I'm using paper towels, or you can use an old clean cloth.



With a wet cloth, wipe the mud away. Remember to wipe the soles too!



Leave your boots to dry.



Next, put on some rubber gloves to protect your hands from the polish.



This is the polish I will be using. It is very easy to use and doesn't make too much mess.

Always read the instructions on the back to check the polish is ok to use on your shoes or boots. Mine is for black leather.



This product has a sponge application that you press down on your boot.



Rub the nozzle all over your boot, making sure you get polish in all the creases. You can see the polish come out onto the sponge.



When you have covered your boots with polish, let the polish sink in for a few minutes.



To finish off, take a clean dry cloth, or paper towel and rub all over to bring out the shine!
