When do we use Capital Letters?

1. At the beginning of a sentence.
2. Names (Proper Nouns)
 - People's names/ titles - Mr John Smith
 - Also names of characters/ pets - Bugs Bunny, Snowy etc.
 - Place names - Street
 - Town/ Cities
 - Countries
 - Landmarks/ Oceans/ Mountains
 - Nationalities - Scottish, Irish, English, Welsh etc.
 - Religion - Christianity, Islam/ Christian, Muslim, etc.
 - Titles - films, books, TV programmes etc.
 - Company/ Brand names - Woolworths, Puma
 - Names of teams/groups - football, rugby, community etc.
3. Days of the week - Saturday etc.
4. Months of the year - October etc.
5. Some forms may require BLOCK CAPITALS
6. Headlines in newspapers
7. The letter "I" when talking about yourself e.g. He thinks I am very clever.
