

Woodland walk Accessible Pathway

Brief

The woodland is an existing public walkway with a natural pathway approximately 650 metres long winding through the woodland.

The college would like to provide a safer pathway to allow students and public of all abilities to access the woodland area.

Specification

- Excavate to reduced levels and remove materials from site.
- Lay clear stone and compact in layers to allow permeability
- Provide and install 100 x 25 treated timber edgings 2 metres apart each side of walkway, edging to be fixed to 50 x 50 mm treated timber pegs.
- Provide and lay firm ground recycled HDPE ground mats with integral membrane.
- Provide and lay clear gravel on HDPE ground mats and compact.
- Ensure ground is level with the timber edgings to the external of the pathway.
- Level site is a clean and tidy condition.
